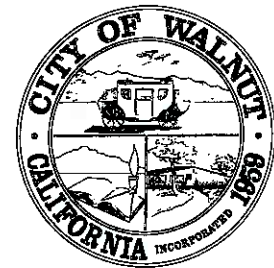

There are 24 miles of equestrian/hiking trails winding through Walnut's rolling hills. The area has been linked to horse-related activities for many years, and interest in an equestrian-oriented life style has attracted many of the present residents to locate in this area. The scenic, rolling natural topography provides an ideal place for riding and hiking. The equestrian/hiking trails are located to provide circulation within the community and to take advantage of other open space facilities, such as parks and natural areas wherever possible. Along the equestrian/hiking trails, there are three rest areas available. The rest areas are located on Valley Boulevard at Lemon Creek Drive, west of Lemon Avenue; on Nogales Street, south of Francesca; and on Lemon Avenue, just north of La Puente Road. All three rest areas have picnic tables, trash cans, and trees to provide shade. The map below indicates the equestrian/hiking trails and rest areas.
